Ana's dedication was further recognized through various honors and awards, including but not limited to the Roots for Success certificate, a 9-month environmental training program advocating for change in Urban America, with Van Jones as one of its advocates. Ana was also a member of the United States Army Reserve, proudly serving her country for over a decade.
