Your memory is a Keepsake from which I'll never part.

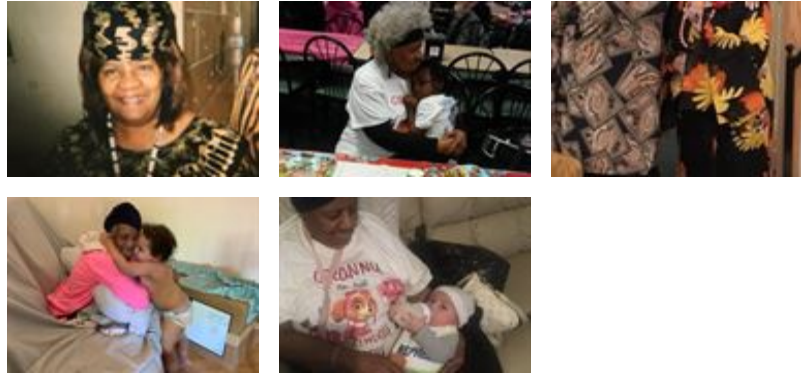

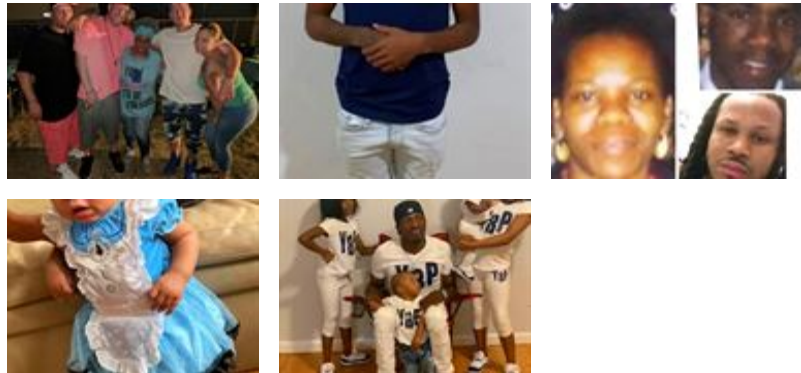
