I remember Auntie Helen coming to me to comfort me by calming my nerves and talking to me, as she pulled out a clear bottle of shiny nail polish, had me to hold out my hand, all while reminding me that for this occasion your hands should look pretty when he's putting a ring on it :). All the while she's also letting me know how happy she was for me, as she assured me that it was going to be a beautiful ceremony so "stop worrying (Val)." So while my mother and sister handled the confusion, Auntie Helen handled and took care of me...one of the things I love her for. Even though she had sons, she made us girls/women feel like her daughters from as far back as I can remember. 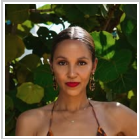
