Holding the memories in our hearts in the meantime.

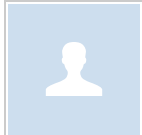

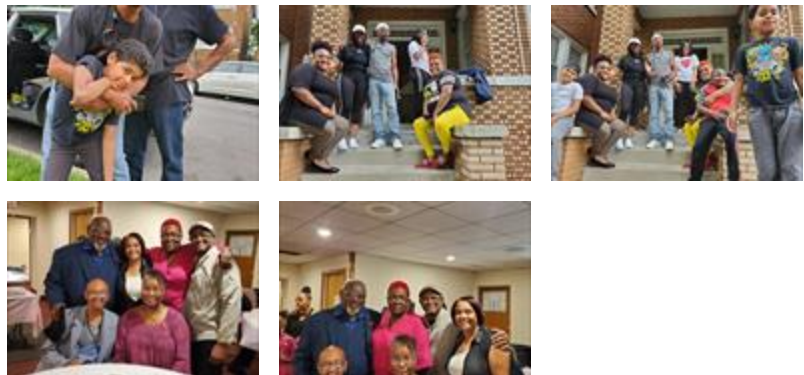
