Lula was such a kind, loving person who loved to travel, to share her faith in God through Jesus Christ, and at one time was an extraordinary seamstress. Until she had to give her full attention to her heath, she and I never missed exchanging gifts, especially at Christmas, and if we remembered, also on birthdays. She was always adamant that I would not stay in a hotel, but in her house. She was gifted by God to up raise three remarkable young men who was given for such a time as this. I want them to know they are in my thoughts and
