I have so many memories of her as a roommate, talking about all sorts of social issues, and of course, boy problems. She, our friend Conni, and I were inseparable the spring semester of 1976, and called ourselves the "Mod Squad". We even had a silly theme song we made up, where we "Hollywood around the campus and drive all the men insane". We had so much fun in those days, playing spoons around the dorm room coffee table, listening to music (Rita called the current favorite song the "jam of the evening"), drinking beer - Schlitz malt liquor, and laughing. Rita always talked about how she wanted to go to London - I hope she was able to go. Rita turned me on to pizza burgers from Avanti's Italian Restaurant - one night we got them to go and were so hungry, we sat down to eat them on the curb!

Rita was a great storyteller and displayed such calm and grace, and her smile lit up the room. A few nights ago, I dreamed that Rita, a friend of hers from ISU, and I all wore pale yellow evening gowns, we all looked glamorous, and we planned to "Hollywood around the campus". I meant to share that dream with her on Facebook. But I can imagine her now in heaven, smiling and laughing as an angel in her pale yellow evening gown. Godspeed, dear friend, I am blessed to have known you.
